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Dear Pueblo's Royal Christian School Families,

I want to inform you about our plans for the upcoming 2020-2021 school year. Below there is a summary of what we covered during our Parent Information meetings. These will be some of the changes implemented for the Fall 2020 semester.

- Students will have 3 attendance options:
 - **1st Option:** Students will attend full time, from 8 a.m. to 3 p.m.
 - **2nd Option:** Students may attend half a day, either from 8 a.m. to 11 a.m. or from 12:00 to 3:00 p.m. Students do not have to attend every day of the week.
 - **3rd Option:** Students may come to school to score, ask questions, and test. They will have structured weekly goals that should be met. **If goals are not met, parents will be contacted. If the problem persists, students will be removed from our program.**
- PreK-Kinder will attend a half day from 8:00 a.m. to 11:00 a.m.
- Tuition price will be the same for all options mentioned above.
- Attendance will be waived for this first semester. However, if students are not meeting their recurring workload, they will be asked to leave our program.
- No Spanish, Music, and PE classes during the 1st Semester
- Academic updates and progress report will be sent out as they are traditionally.
- Our Dual Credit program with San Jacinto College will continue as planned.
- Monthly Bible memory verses will still be required. Students may say their Bible verses when they present themselves to score/test.
- Chapel Service on Wednesday mornings will continue as scheduled.
- Fundraisers will be Postponed until second semester.
- Temperatures will be checked every morning for students and staff; temperatures over 99.9 degrees will not be permitted.
- Masks should be worn in high traffic areas like hallways, entering, exiting, the building etc. Students may remove them in their office, and while eating.
- We will be cleaning/disinfecting with hospital grade solutions every day.
- Lunches will not be made/served. (Possibly prepackaged or microwaveable meals will be sold example: hot-pockets)
- Prepackage Snacks will be available for fruit break/lunch.

At this time, we will be following the P.I.S.D. 2020-2021 academic calendar. As of now, we plan to begin the fall semester on Tuesday, August 18, 2020.

On behalf of our administrators, and staff, we look forward to when we are all back together living our daily routines and participating in normal school activities. I encourage you to continue praying for our school and for a great upcoming school year.
